ERGODIC - Combined Passenger and Goods Transportation in Suburb Traffic

The ERGODIC project aims to demonstrate a novel system for integrated passenger and goods transport, consisting of flexible public transport with modular vehicles and last-mile travel/delivery service with active micro-mobility.
